- **Sign up for a Xanga blog**, edit it to include a link to your micro-niche blog and add the Xanga blog to your Posterous account.

Handy Tip - You will likely have seen by now that Posterous has a number of sites that it can be linked to that we haven't had enough time to cover in The Challenge. The services we have chosen are the ones we feel are the most beneficial in building your link network, but if you have the time and inclination, **signing up for a number of these other services will strengthen and grow your link network further.**
